SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Thank you. Good morning and welcome to today's remote New York City Council vote for the Committee on Criminal Justice. At this time, will all panelists please turn on their videos for verification purposes? To minimize disruptions, please place all electronic devices to vibrate or silent mode. Thank you. Chair, we are ready to begin.

CHAIRPERSON POWERS: Thank you and good morning, everyone. I'm City Council member Keith Powers, Chair of the Committee on Criminal Justice. Today, we are here to vote on Intro 903-A which a bill by Council member Adrienne Adams. This bill would require the Department of Corrections to assist formerly incarcerated individuals to access their unused commissary funds and ensure that any person with unused funds is immediately given up to 200 in commissary funds in cash upon request. Additional

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2 funds would be available by check. The bill will 3 also require the Department to make reasonable 4 efforts to return unused funds of formerly incarcerated individuals and to establish a plan for raising awareness regarding obtaining commissary 6 7 funds. It would also require a yearly report on 8 outstanding funds and the attempts to return such The Department of Corrections currently has \$3.7 million of unclaimed commissary funds that 10 11 belongs to people who have been discharged from 12 correctional facilities. This money has accumulated 13 over many years and many people who are in the 14 Department's custody aren't aware that they have 15 money left in their accounts. This bill would help 16 return money to its rightful owners and I want to 17 thank Council member Adams for her bill which I feel 18 like we put out there about three or four years ago 19 talking about this bill and, of course, I want to 20 thank all the staff who helped with this hearing and 21 have been working on that, as well. And, of course, 2.2 I want to acknowledge many of my colleagues that are 2.3 here today: Council member Holden, Council member Van Bramer, Council member Diaz, Council member Ampry-24 Samuel, Council member Riley, Council member Rivera, 25

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2	and, of course, Council member Adams who is here for
3	her own bill, as well. I don't believe she's making
4	any comments on it today, so we will go ahead and
5	open the vote on Intro 903-A.
