CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: Okay, good morning
My name is Mark Weprin. I'm Chair of the Zoning and
Franchises Subcommittee. I'm joined by the following
members of the Subcommittee: Vincent Gentile, Dan
Garodnick, Donovan Richards, and Vincent Ignizio, who
go the Gold Star today. Take that. From Staten
Island. We have only We have two cafes on our
agenda. The third item on our agenda, Land Use
Number 63, 64, 62 through 65 inclusive is going to be
laid over until a future meeting. So we're going to
do the two cafes. We are going to start with Land
Use Number 61. Is it Xai Xai Wine Bar? You'll
pronounce that for me when I get it. Close enough.
All right. I'm not sure the owners will think that,
but we'll see. Mark Glazer [sp?] is here. That
would be you. So that was close enough there.
You'll pronounce it for me properly Mr. Glazer. So
Mr. Glazer, when you get to the microphone just make
sure if he has See if he can getsit down and
relax. Don't worry. Maybe I should have helped you
out with the mic. The mic is a little confusing
sometimes. So State your name.

MARTIN GLAZER: Martin Glazer.

CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN:	Right, and describe
what your application is and the	e name of the
regtaurant	

MARTIN GLAZER: Oh, the restaurant is called Xai Xai. It's at 369 West 61st Street. This letter serves as our agreement with City Council Member Johnson and the encompassing members of the Subcommittee on Zoning and Franchises that we will commit to the following:

We will close and vacate the sidewalk cafe no later than 10:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and 11:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday.

CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: Well, thank you, Mr. Glazer, and we have been in touch with Mr. Corey

Johnson's office, the Council Member of the area, and he is happy with this resolution and this letter.

I'd like to ask the members of the committee if they have any questions for this gentleman and with Xai

Xai Cafe and Wine Bar. Where are you located exactly?

MARTIN GLAZER: It is at 369 West 51st Street.

CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: Oh, wow. So, you know, some of these guys. Garodnick is not talking

there. He can go by. All right, well thank you. I don't think we have any questions. Thank you very much for coming.

MARTIN GLAZER: Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: Thank you for your patience. I'd like to close the hearing on Land Use Number 61, and we're able to move on to Land Use Number 79, Madison Kaiser Bakery, and Elliott Zygote. Oh, look at that. Welcome, young Mr. Zygote. So just please state your name and describe the application you're representing.

ELLIOTT WYGOTA: My name is Elliott

Wyota, and SWA Architects as an authorized

representative of 1800 Broadway Bakery, LLC in

connection with their application for an unenclosed

sidewalk cafe. And on behalf of 1800 Broadway

Bakery, LLC hereby commits to the City Council and

the Zoning and Franchises Committee that in light of

the concerns of the surrounding community with

respect to the stipulated operating hours for the

sidewalk cafe, 1800 Broadway Bakery, LLC shall:

As per comments from Manhattan Community Board Number 5, the cafe shall open no earlier than 8:00 a.m. daily and close no later than 10:00 p.m.

Sunday through Thursday, and no later than 12:00 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays;

Follow all applicable laws and regulations with respect to the operation of the cafe;

1800 Broadway Bakery, LLC will participate in ongoing meetings with community representatives to discuss any ongoing concerns or problems as they may arise with the intent of developing satisfactory solutions.

CHAIRPERSON FERRERAS: Thank you very much, Mr. Wyota. I'm going to call on Council Member Garodnick who is the Council Member for the Maison Kayser Bakery, and he would like to make a comment.

COUNCIL MEMBER GARODNICK: And I think it's pretty self-explanatory. So we thank you for the letter, and your commitment. But just for the benefit of my colleagues, this was just a denial at the Community Board level with the conditions that are set forth in this letter, the implemented— The conditions were implemented. So as far as I'm concerned this issue is resolved, and we wish you

well, and I thank my colleagues for entertaining this
issue.

CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: See, I love happy endings. Two happy endings today. Elliott, I'm going to go on the record. So I'll be careful, but your relationship with Shomo [sp?] is?

ELLIOTT WYOTA: He's my dad.

CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: All right. Well, welcome. Happy to see you again. Please tell him we treated you nicely because ...

ELLIOTT WYOTA: [interposing] Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: ...we don't like to treat him nicely. [laughter] Okay, well, thank you very much. We're going to close this hearing on Land Use Number 79, and as I mentioned before, the other item on the agenda is laid over until our next meeting. So that's it. A very short happy meeting. We thank the members for coming. We are going to...
