LU No. 0176, 5402 Fort Hamilton Parkway, an application submitted by Fort Hamilton, LLC for a zoning map amendment to change an R5 to an R6 with a C1-3 overlay to facilitate the construction of a 50,000-square-foot commercial community facility building in Borough Park that has been termed a women's health facility; this application is in Brooklyn Community Board 12 and Council Member Menchaca's district.

We also have with us an application that has been withdrawn and subject to a motion to file; that is LU No. 0173, 102 Greene, and a proposed special permit from 102 Greene Owner, LLC to facilitate the enlargement of existing 3-story building within the SoHo Cast-Iron Historic District
