We left off the other day on an item in Brooklyn called the Cherry Hill Text Amendment in Council Member Deutsch's district, so what I'd like to do first is to call on Council Member Deutsch, who has a statement to make and then we will describe for the record the modification. Mr. Deutsch.

COUNCIL MEMBER DEUTSCH: Thank you, Chair and I will also be speaking in a deep voice.

I wanna start off by say... [crosstalk] CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: As usual. You and Garodnick have those good voices you know.

COUNCIL MEMBER DEUTSCH: I wanna start off by saying that I have listened to all the different positions regarding this proposed text amendment; I have weighed the merits of both sides at length in order to make a decision that is best for the 48th District and for the communities that I represent. It is important to preserve the significance of the Special Sheepshead Bay District while adapting and changing to remain relevant and current.

I would like to thank City Planning; after compromising the original text amendment I was able to limit [sic] Cherry Hill to its current usage, SUBCOMMITTEE ON ZONING AND FRANCHISES 4 which addressed a significant issue that the Borough President of Brooklyn and I had with the original application.

I am extremely grateful to the Council's

Land Use Division for working together with me to

insert a ten-year renewal requirement to this

application. With these adjustments I recommend that

my colleagues on the Land Use Committee vote to

approve this text amendment; these changes are

acceptable and will grant Cherry Hill legal status.

The Cherry Hill Market is an important asset to our neighborhood, as it provides a unique service as well as jobs for many residents of our community. The lengthy review process that this applicant went through gave the community the opportunity to review and discuss the pros and cons of this proposal.

I am looking forward to working with all different parties involved and continue to make the 48th District a wonderful place to live, work and raise a family. Thank you.

12	that the text be amended to state that a food store
13	of limited size be allowed in Area B for a period of
14	10 years from the date this amendment becomes
15	effective.
