committee approved a modification to oppose text. 13

Which limits the amount of floor transferrable from 14

conditions requested of both the Community Board and 20

Terminal. Application for maritime lease between the 24

New York City Department of Small Business Services

and the New York Economic Development Corporation for approximately 72 acres of city-owned land for 39

years located along the Sunset Park Waterfront in Council Member Menchaca's district.

We also have four applications from HPD to facilitate new affordable housing projects and-and preserve existing affordable housing.

Land Use No. 225, PRC Andrew Avenue, an application submitted by HPD for a collection of properties located in Council Member Cabrera's and Council Member Arroyo's district.

LU No. 226, 911 Longwood Portfolio, an application submitted by HPD for a grant of the property tax exemption for two buildings located in Council Member Arroyo's district.

LU No. 227, Compass Residence 2A, an application submitted by HPD for the grant of the property tax exemption for another site at 1524 Boone Avenue in Council Member Arroyo's district.

LU No. 228, Beach Green North, an application submitted by HPD for the grant of property tax exemptions for the property located at 45-05 Rockaway Beach Boulevard in Council Member Richard's district. How are you Council Member
