Transmitted here with are the bills signed by the Mayor. The bills are as follows:

<u>Int. 639-B – Local Law 68</u>

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the police department to submit quarterly reports relating to the issuance of summonses.

<u>Int. 662-A – Local Law 69</u>

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the police department to submit quarterly reports relating to the issuance of desk appearance tickets.

<u>Int. 1056-A – Local Law 70</u>

A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to penalties for violating park rules.

Int. 1057-A – Local Law 71

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the enforcement of criminal and civil offenses.

Int. 1058-A – Local Law 72

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the penalties for excessive noise.

Int. 1059-A – Local Law 73

A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to OATH procedures for certain quality of life offenses.

Int. 1067 - Local Law 74

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to penalties for possessing an open container of alcohol.

Int. 1070-A - Local Law 75

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to penalties for littering, and to repeal subdivision 5 of section 16-118 of the administrative code of the city of New York, relating to the distribution of advertising matter.
