Dear Chairman Weisbrod,

On June 15th, 2016 the Land Use Committee of the City Council, by a vote of 17-0-0, recommended modification of the City Planning Commission's decision to approve the disposition of city-owned property as part of application C 160143 HAQ. Pursuant to Section 197-d(d) of the City Charter and Section 11.70 of the Rules of the Council, I hereby file the proposed modification with the commission. For the purposes of this letter, the "Disposition Area" is defined as property located at 133-45 41st Avenue (Block 5037, Lots 64 and 65), Borough of Queens, New York City, New York.

The Council would modify the disposition as follows:

A minimum of 5,000 square feet of any building developed on the Disposition Area shall be restricted to the following uses, as set forth in Sections 22-13 and 22-14 of the New York City Zoning Resolution, for a period of five years from the date of issuance of the first temporary

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certificate of occupancy (TCO) for the entire building, or if no TCO is first issued for the entire building, the first final certificate of occupancy for the entire building:

- 1. Community center or settlement house,
- 2. Non-commercial recreation center.
- 3. Library, museum, or non-commercial art gallery, or
- 4. School.

The proposed modification to the disposition action is fully set forth in the proposed City Council Resolution.
