This bill would expand workforce disclosure requirements for construction contractors on projects of \$1 million or more, and would require construction contractors to disclose demographic and job related information about each employee working for those contractors when such information is voluntarily provided. information would be used to evaluate the effectiveness of the city's many MWBE initiatives and establish a benchmark for the construction industry's efforts to work with MWBEs.
