CHAIRPERSON DROMM: Okay, good morning and welcome to today's Finance Committee meeting, the first of the 2018 to 21... 2021 session. My name is Danny Dromm and I'm the new Chair of this committee. Before...

Before we begin I want to express how excited I am for the opportunity to chair the Finance Committee and express my appreciation to Speaker Johnson for entrusting me with the privilege of being able to serve in this role and I also want to take this opportunity to thank the former Chair, Julissa Ferreras for the excellent job that she did when she was in this role. I'm also looking forward to working with the Finance Division staff led by the council's amazing Finance Director, Latonia McKinney...

CHAIRPERSON DROMM: And to my colleagues on the committee, both those I've served with before and those new to the council, I welcome all of you. as finance committee members we have the unique opportunity to fight for the priorities of this

2	council and for the needs of communities across the
3	five boroughs. I am confident that ours will be a
4	fruitful partnership and that we will make meaningful
5	differences in the lives of New Yorkers over the next
6	four years. Turning to today's business, the
7	committee will be voting on two items. The first is
8	the budget modification that implements changes to
9	the Fiscal 2018 adopted budget by transferring funds
10	between the miscellaneous budget and the council.
11	Additional information on the modification can be
12	found in the committee report distributed by the
13	Finance Committee Staff. The second item is a
14	preconsidered introduction that would extend
15	deadlines for several submissions and hearings
16	concerning the Fiscal 2019 preliminary budget. This
17	includes the Mayor's submission of preliminary budget
18	to no later than February 1 st , '18. The Mayor's
19	submission of the preliminary management report to no
20	later than February 15 th , 2018. The Department of
21	Finance is estimated, estimate of assessed evaluation
22	of real property and certified statement of all real
23	property taxes due and uncollected to no later than
24	March 5 th , 2018 and the council's hearing and
25	submission of recommendations on the preliminary

2	budget and the Mayor's preliminary management report
3	to no later than April 10^{th} , 2018. The full list of
4	changes can be found in the introduction and
5	accompanying committee report. Unless there are any
6	questions on the two items I will ask Billy Martin,
7	the Committee Clerk to call the roll, are there any
