The building located in Council Member Reynoso's district in Brooklyn is a freestanding Colonial Revival home made of brick, terracotta and galvanated iron. The house was

designated in 1900 by Ulrich Huberty, who also designated several other Brooklyn landmarks.

We will voting to approve Preconsidered LU Hopkinson Park Place Tax Exemption Application for properties located at Park Place and Thomas S. Boyland Street just north of East New York Avenue and south of Eastern Parkway. HPD seeks approval of 40year real estate tax exemption pursuant to Article XI of the Private Housing Finance Law to facilitate the construction of three multiple dwellings with 25 homeownership units for the low-income families in Council Member Ampry-Samuel's district in Brooklyn.
