CHAIRPERSON ESPINAL: [GAVEL] Good afternoon. My			
name is Rafael Espinal, I'm the Chair of the			
Committee on Consumer Affairs and Business Licensing.			
Today the committee will be holding a hearing on pre-			
considered intro, a local law to amend the New York			
City charter in relation to adding members to			
Nightlife Advisory Board. In the past several months			
we have come a long way in reforming our city's			
approach to Nightlife. Last session we repealed that			
that our Archaic Cabaret Law and passed a law			
establishing the Nightlife office and the Nightlife			
Advisory Board. I hope that with the establishment			
of the office of Nightlife and a Nightlife Advisory			
Board we can begin the task of updating many more of			
our laws and regulations in order to restore and			
enhance the city's nighttime economy and think			
progressively about new ideas to plan our city, so			
that Nightlife goers, artists, local residence, and			
government can all communicate and live in harmony.			
The bill we are hearing today represents a minor			
amendment to the advisory board adding two additional			
members. One to be appointed by the Mayor and one by			
the council. I am proud of all of the work we've			
done over the last several months and look forward to

the changes at the office of Nightlife and Nightlife Advisory Board will bring about. The committee looks forward to hearing from the Mayor's office, advocates, the industry, and other interested parties on these topics. I would like to call upon, well we're going to call upon the public to testify. Before we do that, I want to recognize that we've been joined by Karen Koslowitz from Queens and again this is a bill that would simply expand the Advisory Board. We want to make sure that all stakeholders or represents the many diverse aspects of our city and be able to have a voice. So, with that said, uhm I want to call up the first panel. Gregg Lewis and also recognize that we have been joined by Peter Ku from Queens.

Good, okay. Good afternoon. My name is Greg
Lewis. I'm representing Community Board 5 here from
Manhattan. Thank you for allowing Manhattan
Community Board 5 to provide testimony on the issue
of adding members to the newly created Nightlife
Advisory Board. How ever many members are ultimately
appointed, we believe it is vital that the committee
includes language in its legislation that would
ensure community boards are represented on the

Nightlife Advisory Board. As written, the law passed
by the Council and signed by Mayor de Blasio in
September 2017, does not guarantee a seat for a
Community Board representative on the Nightlife
Advisory Board. Community boards throughout the city
play a valued and necessary role to balance the
concerns of the Nightlife industry with those of
local residence and neighbors. In representing the
Central Business District in Manhattan, Community
Board 5 reviews dozens of liquor license applications
each month and helps resolve community concerns. We
work directly with the industry and neighbors, as
well as our partners at the State Liquor Authority
and the NYPD to maintain a public review process for
Nightlife applicants and operators, that gives all
stakeholders the opportunity to reach collaborative
agreements. Community Boards deep experience in
dealing with issues related to the Nightlife industry
would add an important perspective to the Nightlife
Advisory Board. As such, we hope the committee will
guarantee a seat for a Community Board representative
and ensure that our perspective is heard. Thank you.
CHAIRPERSON ESPINAL: Thank you. Any questions?

Nope. Alright, thank you. We're going to keep the

hearing open just to make sure that all members of
public have an opportunity to come in and say a few
words on the topic, but we will close the hearing at
2:30, thank you. We don't have anymore testimony
