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CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: [GAVEL] Alright. Good morning everyone. Barry?

COUNCIL MEMBER GRODENCHIK: Oh man.

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: Yes. Good morning everyone and welcome to the Committee on Land Use. am Council Member Rafael Salamanca, the Chair of this Committee. I want to welcome my seen colleagues who are members of this committee. We have council members Gibson, Barron, Deutsch, Kallos, King, Koo, Lancman, and then also Torres, Grodenchik, Chair Adams, Diaz, Chair Moya, and Council Member Rivera. Please excuse my voice, I have a chest cold and I want to give a big shout out to my wife and Aiden who is watching us on T.V. right now. I want to thank Chair Moya, Chair Adams, and Chair Kallos for their work on our Land Use subcommittees. Today, we will be voting to modify LU's 36, the 21st East 12th Street parking garage obligation in Council Member Rivera's district in Manhattan. The modification will reduce a number of parking spaces from 187 to 150. He will be voting to approve LU's 37 and at 35 Underhill Avenue rezoning in Council Member Cumbo's district in Brooklyn. This rezoning would allow the conversion of a portion of the ground floors of an existing

building from parking to commercial use. We will be
voting to approve LU's 38 to Gowanus Canal CSO site
selection and acquisition application for property
in Council Member Levin's district in Brooklyn.
Approval will permit the construction of head and
facility, including an \$8 million-gallon tank
designed to intercept combined sewer overflow
discharges. This project will facilitate compliance
with the federally required remediation of the
Gowanus Canal. We will be voting to approve LU's
41, the Special Projects Loans 165 West 80th Street.
Project and Council Member Rose [inaudible 3:50]
district in Manhattan. This application seeks you
that approval pursuant to General Municipal Law and
enacted exemption pursuant to Article 11 of the
Private Housing Finance law. Approval that will
facilitate the transfer and rehabilitation of the
building resulting in 29 affordable coop apartments
which will be sold to existing tenants for \$250.00
per dwelling unit. Vacating units will be sold to
families earning no more than 120% AMI. We will
also be voting to approve LU's 42 and 43 to CUCS
West 127th Street Supportive Housing Application and
Council Member Perkins District in Manhattan. HPD 6

Urban action development area project UDAAP,
designation and project approval. This position of
city owned property and special permits to allow
community facility floor area ratio to be applied to
the development to create supportive and affordable
housing. These actions will facilitate the
development of a 12-story community facility building
with 34 units reserved for homeless adults and 36
units reserved for homeless families, all with onsite
supporter services and 46 units affordable to low
income individuals and families reserved for
households earning between 50 and 60% AMI. We will
be voting to disapprove LU's 44, the Barano Sidewalk
Café, at 26 Broadway in Council Member Levin's
district in Brooklyn. The surrounding residents
testified that the purposed 34 chairs and 17 tables
will take up valuable public space on a sidewalk,
which is currently used by neighborhood children, who
play there on a daily basis. They also testified that
the noise from the café will have a very negative
impact on the quantity of life. The applicant
testified that it has an as of right option on its
own property adjacent to the sidewalk where it could
have a smaller café. Given these considerations the

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subcommittee recommended this approval. We will be voting to file LU's 50 and application by the Department of City Wide Administrative Services pursuant to Section 195 of the New York City Charter for a notice of intent to require office space for the taxy and limousine commission on a building locator on 188 West 230th street in the Bronx. This application was withdrawn, and it will be removed from the calendar. Are there any questions or remarks from the members of the committee? Alright, seeing none, I will call a vote in accordance with the recommendations of the subcommittees and local council members. So, approve LU's 37, 38, 41, 42, and 43 to approve the modifications I have described LU's 36. To disapprove LU 44 and to file LU's 50. vote of I, is a vote in accordance with these recommendations.
