CHAIR DEBORAH ROSE: Good morning and thank you for coming. My name is Debi Rose and I am the Chair of the Committee on Youth Services. also joined by Council Member Brannan, Council Member Chin and several others on their way. Today we will be voting on Intro 713A which would require the posting of important information pertinent to runaway and homeless youth or RHY. Intro 713A sponsored by Council Member Van Bramer would require that all DYCD funded runaway and homeless youth services prominently place signage informing youth where to call 24 hours a day with questions, comments or complaints regarding the services they receive and other issues. This signage would also include where runaway and homeless youth may find rules governing RHY Service and participant conduct and phone numbers to access mental health resources 24 hours a day. addition, Intro 713A would require that DYCD report annually the number of runaway and homeless youth questions, comments and complaints that are received,

their general nature and the status of responses to these calls including whether any responses resulted in service changes. As we know, runaway and homeless youth are a particularly vulnerable population. city, we owe it to these young people to be able to provide them with resources. In April of 2018 the Committee on Youth Services heard this Bill with feedback from Homeless Advocates, Youth Advocates and youth themselves. Intro 713A has been amended to reflect important changes regarding the provision of information to runaway and homeless youth, including the numbers where they call for help and referrals thus Into 713A will help to bridge the gap that some runaway and homeless youth face where they do not know who to call or when they may call for resources while also strengthening reporting requirements to collect reliable and accurate data on how to serve this population more effectively. As the Chair of the Youth Services Committee. I look forward to continuing to work with runaway and homeless youth and the issues that impact their lives and I would like to thank speaker, Corey Johnson for his commitment to runaway and homeless youth. I would also like to thank my staff, Edwina Martin and Isa
