4	here. We're here to vote on a package of bills that
5	related to the Fire Department operations. Included
6	in today's package are the following bills: Intro
7	744-A sponsored by myself and Council Member Ampry-
8	Samuel who's punctual, Brannan who's not, Kallos and
9	Holden. This legislation will require the Fire
10	Department to report on emergency medical service
11	divisions in stations including relevant supervisory
12	staff and ratios. This reporting will serve an
13	important role in providing transparency regarding
14	the allocation of vital life saving resources. Next,
15	we'll vote on 746-A also sponsored by myself and
16	Council Members Maisel and Holden. Maisel is not
17	punctual. This legislation will require the Fire
18	Department to submit annual reports regarding the
19	potential impact of certain rezonings on the delivery
20	of department services. In doing so, this bill will
21	facilitate the Council's ability to identify and
22	assess changing emergency service needs across the
23	city as we continue to build ever upward and onward.
24	Finally, we will be voting on 1054-A again sponsored

by myself, Council Members Cornegy, Yeger, Holden,

3	legislation will require the Fire Department to
4	establish a system whereby individuals can submit
5	fire alarm plan examinations and inspection paperwork
6	through online portals. This will be an important
7	step in streamlining a currently extremely
8	inefficient process of submitting such plans in
9	person. Since I'm the sponsor, would any one else
10	like to make a statement? Okay, let's got to the
11	vote. Thank you, Bill.

13	Roll call vote Committee on Fire and Emergency
14	Management. All items are coupled. Chair Borelli.
15	CHAIRPERSON BORELLI: Aye on all.
