CHAIRPERSON EUGENE: Good morning or good afternoon, as a matter of fact. My name is Mathieu Eugene and I'm the Chair of the Civil and Human Rights Committee. Today, the committee will be voting on Introductory bill and Number 799 sponsored by the Department of Advocate Jumaane Williams in relation to prohibiting retaliation against individuals who request a reasonable accommodation under the city's Human Rights Law. This legislation would-would affirm that New Yorkers are indeed are protected from retaliation when they request the reasonable accommodation. Currently, the New York City Human Rights Law prohibits retaliation when an individual partakes in a protected activity such as opposing unlawful discriminatory practice filing a complaint with the Commission because are helping the Commission or some Council Members to get their complaint. Although the city's Human Rights Law is suppose to be broadly considered (sic), unfortunately, the Code have excluded the requestshave excluded requests for reasonable accommodation from release of protected activity. The Council wishes to ensure that an individual who requests
