WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on April 28, 2014 its approval dated April 22, 2014 of the petition of 7 Washington Lane Corp., d/b/a Xai Xai, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 369 West 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Community District 4, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
