A Local Law to amend the housing maintenance code of the city of New York, in relation to family succession rights in buildings leased through the tenant interim lease program.

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Article one of subchapter four of the housing maintenance code of the city of New York is

amended by adding a new section 27-2090.1 to read as follows:

§ 27-2090.1 Tenant interim lease program succession rights. The department shall promulgate rules

providing succession rights for family members of tenants where such tenants are occupying dwelling units

within city-owned multiple dwellings participating in the tenant interim lease program described by chapter

thirty-four of title twenty-eight of the rules of the city of New York or a similar successor program.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
