A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to suspending alternate side parking regulations and meter parking regulations on September 11 of each year.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-163 of the administrative code of city of New York is amended by adding a new

subdivision d to read as follows:

d. The department shall suspend all alternate side of the street parking rules on the eleventh day of

September of each year.

§ 2. Subchapter 2 of title 19 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a

new section 19-163.3 to read as follows:

§ 19-163.3. No parking meter or muni-meter shall be activated on the eleventh day of September of

each year.
