A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the installation of energyefficient street lights.

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subchapter one of chapter one of title 19 of the administrative code of the city of New York

is amended by adding a new section 19-157 to read as follows:

<u>§19-157</u> Energy-Efficient Street Light Installation. a. Any lamp to be used in the illumination of streets, highways, parks, or any other public place shall utilize light-emitting diode technology or the best available technology if such technology is more energy efficient than light-emitting diode technology.

b. On or before January 1, 2015 and every six months thereafter, the department shall provide a report to the council and shall post on its website (i) the number of street light fixtures that have been installed with light-emitting diode technology or the best available energy efficient technology as described in subdivision a of this section and (ii) the number of street light fixtures that remain to be installed with lamps utilizing lightemitting diode technology or the best available energy efficient technology as described in subdivision a of this

## section. Such data shall be disaggregated by borough and council district.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon enactment into law.
