WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on July 29, 2016 its approval dated July 27, 2016 of the petition of VER34 LLC, d/b/a Wine 34, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate a small unenclosed sidewalk café located at 127 East 34th Street, Community District 6, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
