Whereas, Bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Serrano, S.6721, and Assembly Member Joyner, A.8419, "AN ACT in relation to authorizing discontinuance of the use as parkland of land in the city of New York commonly known as the Marx Brothers playground"; *and*

Whereas, The enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; *now, therefore, be it*

Resolved, That the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to

enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
