WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on July 14, 2017 its approval dated July 13, 2017 of the petition of While We Were Young, LLC, d/b/a While We Were Young, for a new revocable consent to maintain, operate and use an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 183 West 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
