#### By Council Member Salamanca

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to parking signs near stadiums and arenas

#### Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subchapter 2 of chapter 1 of title 19 of the administrative code of the city of New York is

amended by adding a new section 19-175.6 to read as follows:

§ 19-175.6 Parking signs. a. For purposes of this section, the term "stadium" means a stadium or arena

in the city with a capacity of at least 5,000 spectators in which sporting and other events are performed and

seating or standing room is assigned by issuance of tickets purchased by spectators.

b. Any department sign that imposes parking regulations contingent on the stadium being in use for an

event shall include a link to the schedule on the department's website described in subdivision c of this section.

c. The department shall maintain on its website a schedule for each stadium that includes the dates and

times when parking regulations contingent on the stadium being in use for an event are in effect. The

### department shall update such schedule at least five days in advance of each event.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
