A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the creation of a map of trails accessible to the public in parks and natural areas under the jurisdiction of the parks department

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one of title eighteen of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended

by adding a new section 18-156 to read as follows:

§ 18-156 Maps of trails in parks and natural areas. The commissioner shall make available, on the

department's website, maps of each trail that is accessible for public use in each park and natural area under the

jurisdiction of the department.

§2. This local law takes effect 180 days after it becomes law.
