## By Council Member Dromm

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the commissioner of the department of correction to post a monthly report on detainees on the department's website

#### Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 9 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 9-154 to read as follows:

§ 9-154 Detainee report. The commissioner shall post a report, by the first date of each month, on the

department's website, which shall include the following information based on the average daily population of

the city's jails for the preceding month:

a. The number of inmates in the department's custody that had not been sentenced.

b. The number of inmates in the department's custody18 years of age or older who had been

# incarcerated for more than six months and had not been sentenced.

c. The number of inmates under 18 years of age who have been incarcerated for more than one month

and had not been sentenced.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 60 days after it becomes law.
