A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring towed vehicle storage facilities to provide 24 hour access

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one of title fourteen of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended

by adding a new section 14-140.1 to read as follows:

§14-140.1 Redemption of Towed Vehicles. All storage facilities for towed vehicles operated by the

department shall provide twenty-four hour access for redemption of vehicles stored in such facilities.

§2. Section 20-508 of title 20 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to read as

follows:

§20-508 Storage facilities. Every licensee which stores vehicles shall do so only on premises which

provide twenty-four hour access for redemption of such vehicles and meet such specifications as the

commissioner shall establish by regulation for safeguarding property.

§2. This local law shall take effect 60 days after its enactment into law.
