Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 768 Madison Avenue, Borough of Manhattan (20155582 TCM; L.U. No. 240).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on May 29, 2015 its approval dated May 27, 2015 of the petition of 768 MAD Restaurant, LLC, d/b/a Bar Italia, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 768 Madison Avenue, Community District 8, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
