A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to establishing a goal of zero waste for New York city by 2030

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 16 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 16-143 to read as follows:

§ 16-143 Zero waste goal. a. Diversion of citywide-generated waste. The department shall establish a

goal of diverting citywide-generated waste by one hundred percent by calendar year 2030.

b. If the department determines that such citywide-generated waste diversion goal is not feasible despite

the best efforts of city government, the department shall report such findings and make recommendations with

respect to policies, programs and actions that may be undertaken to achieve such diversion within 180 days of

such determination.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
