2 SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Sound check for the 3 Committee on Land Use. Today's date is April 11, 4 2024, being recorded by Danny Huang in the Committee 5 Room. 6 SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Good morning and 7 welcome to the New York City vote on Land Use in the 8 Committee Room. 9 Chair, we are ready to begin. 10 CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: [GAVEL] All right, 11 good morning and welcome to the Committee on Land 12 Use. I am Council Member Rafael Salamanca. I Chair 13 this Committee. I would like to welcome my esteemed 14 Colleagues who have joined us today. We've been 15 joined by Council Members Moya, Rivera, Chair Riley, 16 Brooks-Powers, Abreu, Farías, Chair Hanks, and 17 Sanchez. 18 I would like to thank Chair Riley and 19 Chair Hanks for their work on our two Subcommittees. 20 Today, we are voting on one project 21 consisting of five separate actions under LUs 30 through 34. We will vote to approve the Willets Point 22 23 Phase II proposal related to property in Council 24 Member Moya's District in Queens. As described by 25 Chair Riley in our Zoning Subcommittee, the second

2	phase of this transformative project would be
3	facilitated by a zoning text amendment to the Special
4	Willets Point District regulations, a zoning special
5	permit to allow a range of bulk and use modifications
6	across the various parcels of the project site, a
7	stadium special permit, a hotel special permit, and
8	approval of changes to the City map.
9	I would like to recognize Council Member
10	Moya for any remarks on this proposal.
11	COUNCIL MEMBER MOYA: Thank you, Chair,
12	for the time allotted to speak on this bill. Good
13	morning to my Colleagues and everyone here today. I'm
14	excited to be here to discuss an important project
15	that will greatly benefit our community, not just in
16	Queens, but New York City. They can clap a little
17	later. When I became a Council Member in 2017, I
18	promised to make affordable housing a top priority,
19	and that's exactly what this project delivers. Today,
20	we are voting to approve 1,400 units of 100 percent
21	affordable housing which means homes that people can
22	actually afford and many units reserved for low-
23	income seniors and formerly homeless individuals
24	combining with Phase I that is already under
25	construction to total 2,500 units of affordable
ļ	

housing. This is definitely a huge step in solving 2 the housing crisis currently hitting our city, but 3 4 we're creating more than just homes here. The plan also includes a new 650-seat elementary school to 5 relieve overcrowding at nearby schools. There will be 6 open space, retail stores, and a 250-room hotel. The 7 8 crown jewel will be the first privately financed 9 electric soccer stadium built with 100 percent union labor and with a 35 percent M/WBE goal. These 10 11 additions will generate over 1,500 permanent jobs and 12 over 14,000 construction jobs. We're not just 13 building homes but economic opportunities for 14 thousands of New Yorkers struggling to make ends 15 meet. Overall, this revitalization is projected to 16 create 6.1 billion in economic impact over the next 17 30 years. This is a massive transformation in an area 18 once known as the Valley of Ashes into a thriving community. We would also be remiss if I didn't 19 20 mention the other commitments to my community. They include a 3-million investment in a community center 21 in my District, 200 million in direct investment in 2.2 23 not-for-profits, a 1-million-dollar endowment to CUNY to create a scholarship in perpetuity for kids in 24 District 21, 1 million to high school career and 25

2 college readiness programs, and a minimum of 1,000 3 free tickets donated annually to not-for-profits and schools. These financial commitments are in addition 4 to the existing 2 million dollars of programming 5 NYCFC provides at no cost to local youth in a 6 community that has long been underfunded and 7 8 underserved. Providing these programs to our youth 9 who are often at risk of gang recruitment are deeply meaningful. 10

11 I'd like to thank Speaker Adams for her partnership here and support of this vision as well 12 as the New York City Football Club who, like me, 13 never stopped believing that Queens could be their 14 15 home, and to my brothers and sisters in labor, the partners at EDC, the Queens Development Group, and 16 17 the dedicated community leaders of the Willets Point 18 Task Force whose support is essential for this 19 project that checks every box, affordable housing, 20 good jobs, economic growth, and community benefits. 21 This is truly a game-changer. Thank you, Chair, for 2.2 this, and thank you to the Land Use team and my Staff 23 for all the work that they've done. Thank you.

2 CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: Congrats. Are 3 there any other Members who wish to make comments or 4 questions? 5 Seeing none, I will call for a vote with Council Member Moya's support to approve LUs 30, 31, 6 7 32, 33, and 34. 8 Will the Clerk please call the roll? 9 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Good morning. William Martin, Committee Clerk. Roll call 10 11 vote Committee on Land Use. All items are coupled. 12 Chair Salamanca. 13 CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: I want to start by 14 congratulating Chair Moya on negotiating a great 15 project. The amenities that you've received here, you

16 should be extremely excited and humbled about it, and 17 I think that it was a great package that you're 18 delivering for your District. Just to be clear, they 19 were first trying to bring the soccer stadium to the 20 Bronx, but it's too bad that they couldn't put that 21 package together so they went to the next best 2.2 borough, Queens. With that, congratulations. I vote 23 aye on all.

COUNCIL MEMBER MOYA: Thank you, Chair.
COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Moya.

2 COUNCIL MEMBER MOYA: I proudly vote aye. 3 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Rivera. COUNCIL MEMBER RIVERA: Congratulations to 4 Council Member Moya. Incredible. I vote aye. 5 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Riley. 6 7 COUNCIL MEMBER RILEY: Congratulations, 8 Council Member Moya. I proudly vote aye. 9 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Brooks-10 Powers. 11 COUNCIL MEMBER BROOKS-POWERS: I vote aye. 12 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Abreu. 13 COUNCIL MEMBER ABREU: Congratulations, 14 Moya. Really excited for you. 16,000 jobs, a new 15 school, retail space, 2,500 units of housing. I mean 16 it's really remarkable, and it's great that you 17 leveraged everything, that you gave it your all. I 18 vote aye. 19 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Thank 20 you. Farías. COUNCIL MEMBER FARÍAS: I proudly vote 21 aye. As Chair of the Committee on Economic 2.2 23 Development, excited to see this EDC project go forward and super proud and congratulations, Council 24 25 Member Moya.

2	COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Hanks.
3	COUNCIL MEMBER HANKS: Congratulations to
4	Council Member Moya. This is a project, you know I'm
5	from Staten Island, but it is a project that everyone
6	is looking at and everyone is talking about how
7	significant it is, and so I proudly vote aye.
8	Congratulations.
9	COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Hudson.
10	Sanchez.
11	COUNCIL MEMBER SANCHEZ: Congratulations,
12	Council Member Moya. Please share those free tickets
13	for other communities. Congratulations. This is so
14	many years in the making. It's a really big deal.
15	COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Borelli.
16	COUNCIL MEMBER BORELLI: I just want to
17	say it's amazing what good stuff is happening. A lot
18	of us didn't realize this was a priority for Council
19	Member Moya. The NYCFC kept coming to me and they
20	kept saying we can't get this guy Moya interested in
21	soccer in Queens. Luckily, he has some friends who
22	really carried the burden for you and got this done.
23	In all seriousness, congratulations. This is a baby
24	that you have really shepherded for a long time so I
25	proudly vote aye.

2	COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: With a
3	vote of 10 in the affirmative, zero in the negative,
4	and no abstentions, all items have been adopted by
5	the Committee.
6	CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: All right, thank
7	you. That concludes today's business.
8	I would like to thank the members of the
9	public, my Colleagues, Land Use and Council Staff,
10	and the Sergeant-at-Arms for attending today's
11	hearing.
