6 Vacca and I'm Chair of the Committee on  
7 Transportation and today we are here to vote on three  
8 bills.

9 First, there is proposed Intro 234-A,  
10 which I introduced, which would consolidate the taxi  
11 and limousine commission existing advisory boards  
12 into one board consisting of 24 members from all  
13 segments of the industry and advocates ranging in  
14 interest.

15 Next we'll vote on Council Member Levin's  
16 proposed Intro 904-A, a bill that would require that  
17 the Department of Transportation's interagency  
18 roadway plan be updated every five years.

19 Finally, we will vote on Council Member  
20 Ignizio and Oddo's bill, proposed Intro 1155-A, a  
21 bill that seeks to clarify when right turns are  
22 permitted from bus lanes.

23 All these bills have been discussed in  
24 Committee at length, they've been amended and I would  
25 recommend that members vote aye on these bills. So I
