Today, we will vote to approve LUs 80 for the landmark designation of the New York Public Library, Tremont Branch in Council Member Feliz's District in the Bronx.

We will also vote to approve LU 81 for the 104-108 West 139th Street ANCP Cluster and Council Member Salam's District in Harlem. The vote is to approve designation of an Urban Development Action Area, approval of an Urban Development Action Area project, the related disposition of the City-owned land to a developer selected by HPD, and a real property tax exemption pursuant to Article XI of the Private Housing Finance Law. Together, these actions will facilitate the development of an affordable homeownership housing project with approximately 73 units in Harlem.

We will also vote to approve LUS 84 and 85 for the Red Hook Coastal Resiliency Project and Council Member Avilés' and Hanif's District in Brooklyn. This project would facilitate the acquisition of a real property and changes to the City map as part of the important Flood Protection System initiative.
