COMMITTEE: Housing and Buildings

TITLE: To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to including environmental concerns as a guiding principle and purpose of the New York city construction codes.

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION: Proposed Int. No. 267-A would add environmental concerns as a guiding principle and purpose within the intent provisions of the New York City construction codes, which include the Building Code, Plumbing Code, Mechanical Code and Fuel Gas Code.
