I would like to welcome my esteemed

Colleagues who have joined us today. We've been

joined by Council Member Moya, Chair Riley, Farías,

Chair Hanks, Hudson, Sanchez, and Borelli. I would

like to thank our Colleagues for joining us today.

Today, we are voting on a number of items recommended to us by our Zoning and Landmarks

Subcommittee, and I would like to thank Chair Riley and Chair Hanks for their work leading these two Subcommittees.

I would first like to note that LU 74 relating to the West 124th Street tax amendment proposal is laid over.

Today, we will vote to approve the modifications LUs 59 and 60 for the 817 Avenue H rezoning proposal in Council Member Louis' District in Brooklyn. The proposal includes a zoning map amendment and related MIH text amendment and will facilitate the development of approximately 42 residential units subject to MIH. Our modifications will reduce the area to be rezoned from an R5 to an R7A, providing a transition between the development site and existing neighboring lower scale homes. We will also modify the zoning text amendment to similarly reduce the applicable MIH area and also to remove MIH Option 2 and add a deep affordability.

We will vote to approve LUs 64 through 67 for the 281-311 Marcus Garvey Boulevard proposal related to property in Council Member Ossé's District in Brooklyn. The application consists of a zoning map amendment, zoning text amendment, two zoning special permits, which together will facilitate the development of two mixed-use residential buildings in the Bed-Stuy with approximately 155 affordable units

subject to MIH and commercial and community facility
space.

We will vote to approve the modifications

LUS 68 and 69 for the 1289 Atlantic Avenue proposal

also located in Bed-Stuy in Council Member Ossé's

District. This proposal includes a zoning map

amendment and related zoning text amendment to

facilitate the development of a mixed-use residential

building with approximately 112 affordable

apartments, community facility, and ground floor

retail. Our modification will be to remove MIH Option

2 and add the Deep Affordability Option.

We will also vote to approve the PreConsidered Application number G 240051 GAM, a request
for a favorable resolution in support of HPD's
application for funding through the New York State
Restore New York Communities Initiative in connection
with the Timbale Terrace Mixed-Use Affordable Housing
Project in Council Member Salaam's District.

Finally, we will also vote to approve the modifications LU 63 for the disposition of property located at 97-22 Cresskill Place in Council Member Williams' District in Queens. This is an application by DCAS seeking approval for the disposition of City-

agencies to determine whether there is a public need for the site.
