**Summary of Legislation:** This bill would require the Department of Transportation (DOT), in consultation with the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH), to conduct a two-year pilot program on the use of cool pavement on city streets. The pilot must include at least four neighborhoods that are both disadvantaged and heat vulnerable. DOT must also submit a report with its findings to the Mayor and the Council within 180 days after the pilot program has concluded.
