Sgt. Caban was assigned to the 3rd Bttalion, 7th Special Forces Group (Airborne), Fort Bragg, North Carolina.

Marine Cpl. Julian A. Ramon, 22, of Flusing, N.Y., died on July 20, 2006 while conducting combat operations in Iraq's Anbar province. He was assigned to the 3rd Battalion, 8th Marine Regiment, 2nd Marine Division, 2nd Marine Expeditionary Force, at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina.

Spc. Hai Ming Hsia, 37, of N.Y., N.Y., died on August 1, 2006 during combat operations in Ar Ramadi, Iraq. Spc. Hsia was assigned to the 6th Infrantry Regiment, 1st Armored Division, Baumholder, Germany.

At a later point in the Meeting, the Speaker (Council Member Quinn) also asked for a Moment of Silence in memory of NYPD officer Eric Concepcion, 29, of the Bronx, who was killed while off-duty on the West Side Highway on August 14, 2006 after being struck and dragged on his motorcycle by a drunken motorist. He was a six-year veteran and leaves behind a wife and two young daughters.
