16	Today, the Committee's voting on the
17	following legislation. Proposed Intro. 1125-A,
18	sponsored by Council Member Lincoln Restler, a local
19	law to amend Administrative Code of the City of New
20	York in relation to requiring the Department of
21	Education to report on school librarians and library
22	access in New York City Public Schools. The Committee
23	previously heard testimony on this legislation at an
24	April 8th, 2025, hearing on ensuring equity and
25	access in the arts.

2 We are joined today by Council Member 3 Lee, Louis, Stevens, Schulman, Krishnan, Narcisse, 4 and, remote, we have Dinowitz, Gutiérrez, Hanif, 5 Hanks, and Sanchez.

Despite state requirement, far too many 6 7 students in New York City don't have access to certified school librarians. In 2023, Chalkbeat 8 9 reported that in DOE school system of about 1,600 schools, there are only around 260 certified school 10 11 librarians. Their analysis also found that nearly a 12 third of City schools with more than 700 students, 13 schools that are required under State law to have 14 certified full-time library did not have one listed 15 in their budgets. These gaps are even more pronounced 16 in schools serving high poverty communities. This 17 bill shines a light on these gaps so we can work 18 towards a future where every student has access to a 19 certified librarians they are entitled to under the 20 law. I encourage all of my Colleagues to vote yes on 21 this important piece of legislation. 2.2 I would like to thank my Staff and 23 Committee Staff, and I will now turn to the Clerk to
