CHAIRPERSON BRANNAN: [GAVEL] Okay. Good morning, and welcome to today's Finance Committee meeting. I'm Council Member Brannan. I have the privilege of chairing the Committee on Finance. We've been joined this morning by Council Members Powers, Brooks-Powers, Brewer, Farías, Ossé, Hudson, Williams, Carr. On Zoom, we have Sanchez, Louis, and Moya.

Today, the Committee will be voting on the following items. A Resolution, prime sponsored by me, to approve a modification of the City's budget

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pursuant to Charter Section 107E. This Resolution 3 would approve a request received from the Director for the Office of Management and Budget to 4 appropriate new City revenues in FY25 in the amount 5 of 1.2 billion dollars, as reflected in the City's 6 January Financial Plan. Second, a Transparency 7 8 Resolution to approve the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations set to receive funding in the expense budget and, finally, 10 11 two Resolutions to approve real property tax exemptions under Article XI of the Private Housing 12 13 Finance Law. One of these pre-considered Article XI 14 resolutions would authorize a full 40-year exemption 15 from real property taxes for the MBD Cluster 3 in 16 Council Member Sanchez's District, which includes the rehab of five buildings. The project will consist of 17 173 rent-stabilized units, restricted to 60 percent 18 19 or below AMI, Area Median Income. The second of these 20 pre-considered Article XI resolutions would authorize 21 a full 40-year exemption from real property taxes for the Settlement SHF Cluster project in Council Member 2.2 2.3 Feliz's and Stevens' Districts. This involves the rehabilitation of four buildings. The project will 24 consist of 168 rent-stabilized units, restricted to 25
