Summary of Legislation: This bill requires the Department of Investigation (DOI) to annually report on the New York City Police Department's (NYPD) compliance with the Freedom of Information Law. This report would include request types and NYPD's response times. DOI would also provide recommendations to improve compliance with the Freedom of Information Law.

Effective Date: Immediately upon enactment

It is anticipated that DOI will require \$365,000 in annual Personal Service (PS) resources (excluding fringe) to hire five staff within the Office of the Inspector General for the New York City Police Department and the Data and Analytics Team to address the new volume of request and analysis required in the legislation.

Salary cost include:

- three analysts (salary \$65,000),
- a supervisor (salary \$85,000), and
- a quality control specialist (salary \$85,000).
