Proposed Intro No. / Title: *Int. 1460/ A local law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to access to encrypted police radio*

Sponsors: Council Member Brewer, the Public Advocate (Mr. Williams) and Council Members Marte, Hanks and Salaam

Committee: Committee on Public Safety

Summary of Legislation: This bill would require the New York City Police Department to adopt a written policy regarding access to encrypted radio channels. Such policy will protect sensitive information and require real-time access to encrypted radio for professional journalists, and emergency service organizations, and time-delayed access to communications for the general public.

Effective Date: Immediately upon enactment
