If any Council Member has a potential conflict of interest with any of the organizations listed, they have the opportunity to disclose the conflict at the time of their vote.

As a reminder, please disclose any conflicts you may have with proposed subcontractors used by organizations sponsored by discretionary funding. These disclosures must be made before the subcontractor can be approved.

Disclosure forms must be completed and submitted prior to the vote on the Transparency Resolution and may be emailed to Everton Smith, who is also present today in the Chambers to answer of your questions.
