Summary of Legislation: This legislation would require the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) to produce a report on Parks Enforcement Patrol (PEP) officers and Urban Park Rangers. The report must include the number of PEP officers and Urban Park Rangers employed by DPR and the number of vacancies, the number of PEP officers and Urban Park Rangers assigned to each borough, a list of parks where PEP officers and Urban Park Rangers are assigned and deployed, and a description of incidents that required the intervention of a PEP officer or urban park ranger.

Effective Date: Immediately upon enactment
