Dear Councilman,

Thank you for considering the opinion of the local residents in respect to the approval of the sidewalk café for Barano Restaurant located at 26 Broadway, in Brooklyn.

Following the community board's 13-16 vote in favor of the sidewalk café, we would like the council to consider the following compromises in order to maintain a decent quality of life for the residents who live within close proximity of the restaurant.

The resident's main concern about the sidewalk café is the noise that will impact the residents directly above the restaurant. The building where Barano is located is a glass-fronted condo building, which was not originally well constructed during development for this type of operation.

As a result, significant investment by the restaurant has been made in order to make the space suitable for the business to operate. This includes a large-scale effort to sound-proof the inside of the restaurant and the installation of a robust exhaust system to ventilate the wood burning oven that was emitting noxious smoke into all apartments at the backside of the building.

In order to alleviate the impact of the sidewalk café please consider the following:

- **Shortening the hours of the cafe from 10:30pm/12:00am to 9:00pm on weekdays and weekends**
 - Having shorter hours will dramatically reduce the outdoor noise when the children who live directly above the restaurant are trying to sleep. Currently, four children live immediately above the sidewalk café on the second floor (Ages 2, 7, 9, and 14 months).
 - Young children also live on the floors directly above the second floor.
- **Reducing the amount of tables outdoors**
 - Currently Barano's architectural plan calls for the largest sidewalk café in South Williamsburg.
 - By reducing the amount of tables, less noise and less people will be produced from the café.
- **Replacement of resident's windows/ventilation units that are impacted**
 - Residents that live in 26 Broadway and 20 Broadway have very little recourse with the restaurant in the event that daily disruption is present for 5-6 months during the year.

- If the situation does become an ongoing nuisance for the residents of the building, it would be appropriate for the restaurant to address the concerns similar to the other concessions that were made in the past.
- **Additional security for 26 Broadway and 20 Broadway and the surrounding area**
 - Both of the buildings mentioned above do not have full time security or doormen. In order to ensure that the security of the building is maintained, additional security cameras and signs could be added to the front of restaurant to discourage criminal behavior.
 - Additionally, many neighborhood children play outside of the building, which will continue when the sidewalk café is open. We want to ensure that the children have some sense of security outside with so many more people expected in the same vicinity.

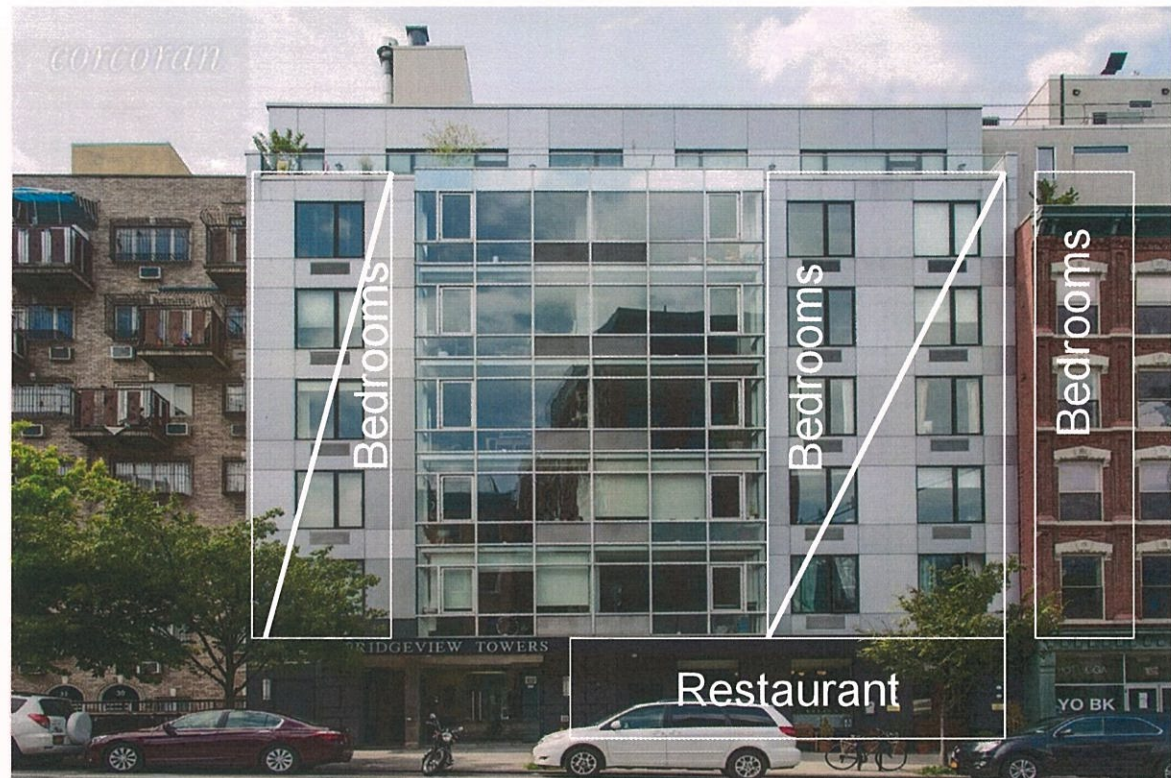

Noise

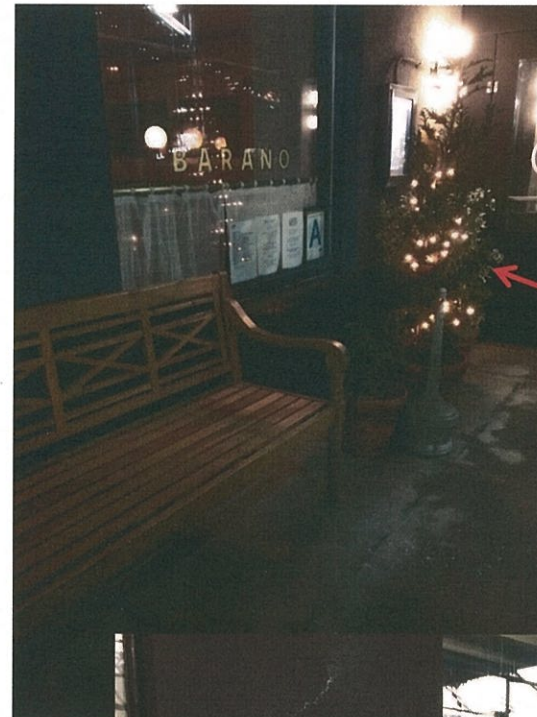
- 26 Broadway is a glass building – not conducive to noise
- **Noise** coming through the non-sound proof windows and ventilation units **is already a problem.**
- The **sidewalk café will introduce additional noise** from talking, plates, set-up and break-down daily



- As confirmed by the restaurant owners, there is little they can do to control the noise
- Lastly, Children (ages 3 and 9) live on the second floor of this building.
- In 20 Broadway, a 14 month old baby lives on the 2nd floor.
 - Given the restaurant's hours are until 10:30pm/12:00am on weekends, this will prevent sound sleeping for these children

Smoke

- The sidewalk café will introduce more smokers to the area
- Residents will not be able open their windows in summer
- More cigarette butts will be in front of the building where children play
- While smoking is not allowed in the sidewalk café, diners can just step out of the perimeter and smoke there

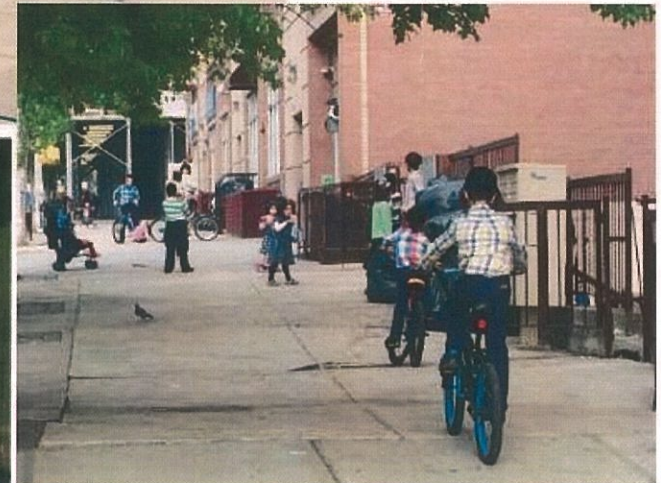

Community Impact

- **Numerous children** who live in the neighborhood play on the sidewalk every day
- The sidewalk café encroaches on this area where children play
- The café also presents **security and privacy issues** for these children and building residents



Community Opposition

- Every single building on the block is in opposition to the sidewalk café.



Community Benefit

- **We urge the community board to vote NO** for this unenclosed sidewalk café given significant opposition from entire neighborhood of 9 buildings affected
 - The sidewalk café does provides **only negative impact** to the community
 - The **only beneficiaries** of the sidewalk café **are the owners of the restaurant** who benefit by making more money at the expense of the welfare of permanent residents of the neighborhood
 - **The restaurant's success does not hinge on this sidewalk café.**
 - Outdoor seating is not critical to run a successful restaurant
 - 80+ seats already available indoors
 - Already in successful operation as is for 2 years
 - Not as critical for success to have outdoor café as to have liquor license



APPENDIX

Restaurant History

- Construction - 2015/16
 - During construction, many residents suffered flat tires due to loose nails left all over the parking garage
 - Noise from construction was unbearable at times
 - Toxic concrete dust was left for months for people and children to breathe in the common areas
- Restaurant Opened – Q1 2016
 - Residents experienced increased noise and disruption especially on lower floors
 - Thick smoke from the restaurant's wood burning oven polluted residents apartments, including those with young children who then complained of breathing problems
 - Ventilation installed but tremendous noise from the system disturbed residents and kept children from sleeping
- Present Day
 - Shared common areas are filthy and unkempt (Barano office entrance, shared elevator)
 - Application for sidewalk café filed, negating all previous efforts to control the noise from the restaurant
 - No discussion with residents around sidewalk café despite known opposition until it was brought up at CB meeting
 - Complete acknowledgement that this café will bring noise and disruption to the community without any options to help alleviate the issues or concerns
