Today, the Committee will be voting on four property tax Pre-Considered Resolutions. First Resolution is a renewal of an expired partial 40-year Article V exemption for one building in Council Member Feliz's District. As part of the application, all units will be restricted to 50 percent AMI retroactive to 2022 when the exemption expired.

Second Resolution is a renewal of an expired partial 40-year Article V exemption of three buildings in Council Member Salamanca's District. As part of the application, all units will be restricted to 50 percent AMI retroactive to 2021 when the exemption expired.

existing partial 40-year Article V exemption for one building in Council Member Ossé's District. Under the application, all units will be restricted to 50 percent AMI, and the building will set aside 30 percent of units for formerly homeless tenants and complete identified capital work according to the integrated physical needs assessment.

The final Resolution is a new partial Article XI exemption for three buildings in Council Member Salamanca's District. Under the application, the building will enter into an HPD regulatory agreement restricting rents at 50 percent AMI and complete construction needs restoring the sidewalks and street curbs, among other needs.
