At this time, I'd like to remind everyone to please silence their electronic devices and at no point going forward is anyone to approach the dais.

Chair, we are ready to begin.

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: [GAVEL] All right.

Good morning, and welcome to the Committee on Land

Use. I am Council Member Rafael Salamanca, Chair of

this Committee. I would like to welcome my esteemed

Colleagues who have joined us today. We've been

joined by Deputy Speaker Ayala, Moya, Abreu, Chair

Hanks, Hudson, Sanchez, and Minority Leader Ariola.

Today, we are voting on nine proposals referred to us by our Subcommittees. As always, I would like to thank Chair Riley and Chair Hanks for their ongoing leadership.

I want to note up front that a few of the items that had originally appeared on today's agenda were laid over in Subcommittees, so we will not be

voting on them today. Those include LU 414 for the 2149-2153 Pacific Street Article XI Request, LU 420 for the Brooklyn CD5 Walk to Park Site Selection, LU 421 for the Queen CD3 Walk to Park Site Selection, and LUs 426 and 427 for the MTA 125th and Lexington Avenue Rezoning Proposal. These items will be voted at a future meeting.

And now for our votes. Today, we will vote to approve LU 364 for the New York City Health and Hospital and Lincoln Recovery Application by New York City Health and Hospital for the disposition of property located in Deputy Speaker Ayala's District in the Bronx.

Next, we will vote to approve five LPC designations for buildings located in Midtown

Manhattan. One of these, LU 415, for the Barbey

Building in Council Member Powers' District. The remaining four LUs 416, 417, 418, and 419 for the 29th Street Tower, Fashion Tower, Furcraft building, and Leftcourt Clothing Center are all located in Council Member Bottcher's District.

We will vote to approve with modifications LUs 422 and 423 for the 1720 Atlantic Avenue Rezoning Proposal in Council Member Ossé's

District in Brooklyn. The proposal includes a zoning text amendment and related zoning map amendment to facilitate the development of a new mixed-use residential building and approximately 314 apartments. Our modification will be to strike MIH

Option One and Two and add Option Three.

We will vote to approve LUs numbers 429 and 430 for the 1551 Broadway Midtown Signage Text Amendment in Council Member Bottcher's District in Manhattan. The proposal includes a zoning text amendment related to sign regulations for small sites in the Special Midtown District and a zoning special permit pursuant to modified text. Together, these actions will facilitate the replacement of existing advertising signage in Times Square with more modern panels.

We will also vote to approve LU 433 for the Praise Tabernacle application by HPD related to property in Speaker Adams' District in Queens. The proposal seeks an Urban Development Action Area designation and UDAAP approval to facilitate the continuation of an existing community facility.

Now, I would like to recognize any of my Colleagues who would like to make remarks, but before
