Summary of Legislation: This legislation requires the Department for the Aging (DFTA) to establish a graband-go meal program, which shall provide daily grab-and-go meals at participating Older Adult Centers. DFTA must also provide each participating Older Adult Center with signage displaying information on the grab-and-go meal program.

Impact on Expenditures (Expense):

It is anticipated that DFTA would require \$3,050,000 in Other Than Personal Service (OTPS) resources to establish the grab-and-go meals program as detailed in the legislation. This is calculated based on an estimated 3,050,000 currently provided meals needing to be packaged for grab-and-go availability, at a packaging cost of \$1.00 per meal. The number of meals that must be made available for grab-and-go will depend upon eventual demand and could vary. This estimate assumes 50% of the 6,100,000 meals currently provided by Older Adult Centers would need to be packaged for grab-and-go availability.
