11 COUNCIL MEMBER YEGER: Madam President? I rise for
12 a Point of Order.

13 MAJORITY LEADER FARIÁS: Granted

14 COUNCIL MEMBER YEGER: Thank you, under the
15 Charter of Section 42, the Council is required
16 publish and make publicly available a proposed agenda
17 for every meeting of the Council at least 36 hours
18 prior to the meeting. The Council did not do that. As
19 of midnight last night, there was no such agenda
20 posted. There was no such agenda sent to the council
21 members, and my understanding is that until this
22 morning, that was not done.

24 MAJORITY LEADER FARIÁS: We were noticed on this
25 past Friday, so that accounts for the timeframe.

3 the Charter requires that at least 36 hours prior to
4 a Stated Meeting of the Council, or as soon as
5 practicable, prior to a Special Meeting, this is a

7 publicly available a proposed agenda for such a
8 meeting. The Council's website said, "No Agenda
9 Available".

11 MAJORITY LEADER FARIÁS: Thank you, Council Member
12 Yeger, Point heard and acknowledged, but we were
13 posted more than 36 hour timeframe for the Stated
14 Meeting. And... [CROSS-TALK]

15 COUNCIL MEMBER YEGER: Point of Information, Madam
16 President?
