COUNCIL MEMBER ROSENTHAL: [Gavel] Good morning. Welcome to the Committee on Women in the New York City Council. Today is April 23, 2018. My name is Helen Rosenthal and I have the honor of chairing this committee. I want to welcome my colleagues Majority Leader Laurie Cumbo, the ever-wonderful Majority Leader, Laurie Cumbo. My colleague from the Bronx and Manhattan, Diana Ayala and from Iala[SP?] and from Brooklyn.

COUNCIL MEMBER LANDER: Most days.

COUNCIL MEMBER ROSENTHAL: Most days, Council Member Brad Lander. Earlier this month, the Council passed the stop sexual harassment in New York City Act. A package of bills aimed at addressing, preventing, and changing the culture around sexual harassment in the work place. This historic legislation creates important safe guards to protect New Yorkers who experience, witness, or report sexual misconduct. This preconsidered INTRO, which we're looking at today currently filed under 2018-1794 makes technical corrections to that package. Specifically, it amends INTRO 612A to clarify that the Department of City Wide Administrative Services is responsible for approving the sexual harassment

2 training to be used by city agencies and amends INTRO
3 664A to clarify the deadline by which the climate
4 surveys must be made available. I'd like to thank
5 the Council Staff as always for their meticulous
6 attention to detail and for your ongoing work on this
7 package and I'd also like to take this opportunity to
8 again thank Speaker Cory Johnson for his leadership
9 and support in stewarding this package of
10 legislation. With that if there are no comments from
11 my colleagues, we will vote on the bill.
