LU 0232-2002 Landmarks Preservation Commission designation no. DL - 336, LP - 2113, pursuant to §3020 of the New York City Charter, concerning the designation of the Plant and Scrymer Pavillions for Private Patients at St. Lukes Hospital , located at 401 West 113th Street, Borough of Manhattan, Council District no. 9, as a landmark. (Non-ULURP no. 20035012 HKM).

LU 0233-2002 Landmarks Preservation Commission designation no. DL - 336, LP - 2105, pursuant to §3020 of the New York City Charter, concerning the designation of the Hamilton Heights/Sugar Hill Northwest Historic District, generally bounded by Convent Avenue and West 151st Street and the west side of St. Nicholas Avenue, just south of West 151st Street, north to the southwest corner of St. Nicholas Avenue and West 155th Street, Borough of Manhattan, Council District no. 7, as a landmark.
