Welcome to the meeting of the Subcommittee 16 on Landmarks, Public Sitings and Dispositions. I am 17 Council Member Kamillah Hanks, and I am the Chair of 18 the Subcommittee. Today, I am joined by my Colleague, 19 Council Member Marte. 20 Today, we'll be holding one hearing 21 followed by votes on (AUDIO STOPS) a speaker card, and we will call your name at the appropriate time. 22 23 For anyone wishing to submit written testimony on the 24 items being heard today, we ask that you please send it via email to landusetestimony@council.nyc.gov. 25

No video recording or photography is allowed from the witness table. 12 13 Further, members of the public may not present audio 14 or video recordings as testimony but may submit 15 transcripts of such recordings to the Sergeant for 16 including in the hearing record. 17 I will now open the public hearing up for Pre-Considered Land Use for Brook 156, an application 18 19 by the New York City Housing Preservation and 20 Development for an amendment to a previously approved project summary in connection with a previous 21 approved Council Resolution from 2019. The amendment 2.2 23 would update the project summary to allow for commercial use in addition to the previously approved 24 community facility use at the ground floor. The 25

JUSTIN DONLON: Justin Donlon. 14 15 COMMITTEE COUNSEL: Do you affirm to tell 16 the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth 17 in your testimony before this Subcommittee and in 18 answer to all Council Member questions? 19 JUSTIN DONLON: I do. 20 CHAIRPERSON HANKS: Thank you. Thank you. 4 JUSTIN DONLON: Thank you, Chair. 5 Hopefully, you all haven't gotten sick of seeing me 6 too much yet. 7 Brook 156 was previously approved by Council in June of 2019 with FIPS designated as 8 9 sponsor for development of the project, and it is a nine-story mixed-use 100 percent affordable housing 10 11 development in the Melrose neighborhood of the Bronx in Chair Salamanca's District. It closed in 2020 and 12 13 was completed in 2024. The previous approval allowed for the construction of community facility space 14 15 though ultimately a commercial use, in this case, a 16 bodega was utilized. So, consequently, in order to 17 establish regulatory compliance, HPD is requesting an 18 amendment to the original project which would specify 19 community facility or commercial use instead of 20 exclusively community facility use as was in the 21 original project summary. Otherwise, the project 2.2 remains entirely the same. 23 CHAIRPERSON HANKS: Thank you so much. I would like to recognize any of my Colleagues. Does 24 anyone have any questions or remarks? 25

Counsel, are there any members of the 4 public who wish to testify on this item? 5 COMMITTEE COUNSEL: No. 6 7 CHAIRPERSON HANKS: Okay, thank you. If there are any remote public participants who wish to 8 9 testify that haven't already done so, please press the raise hand button now and, if you are here with 10 11 us in person, please ask the Sergeant-at-Arms to fill 12 out a speaker card. 13 With there being no members of the public who wish to testify in the Pre-Considered Land Use 14 15 for an amended project summary for Brook 156, this 16 public hearing is now closed. Thank you. 17 We will now keep the proceeding open for 18 a vote so we'll be pausing for the record. 19 Thank you. So, we are continuing with our 20 proceeding of the Subcommittee on Landmarks, Public 21 Sitings and Dispositions. Just for the record, I have 2.2 been joined by my Colleagues, Brannan, Farías, Marte, 23 and Nurse. Today, we are holding several votes for 24 the items previously heard by the Subcommittee, a 25

SUBCOMMITTEE ON LANDMARKS, PUBLIC SITINGS AND 1 DISPOSITIONS 8 vote to approve Land Use 251 for the 447-seat (sic) 2 3 primary school facility, an application submitted by 4 New York City School Construction Authority for the site selection for a new approximately 547-seat 5 primary school facility in Majority Leader Farías' 6 7 District in the Bronx; a vote to approve Land Use Items 252 and 253 for the West 128-129 Street Cluster 8 9 Project; an application by HPD for an approval of an Urban Development Action Area Project and an approval 10 11 of an Article XI tax exemption to facilitate the preservation of four buildings in Council Member 12 13 Salaam's District in Manhattan; a vote to approve the 14 Pre-Considered Land Use Item and amended project 15 summary for Brook 156, which is an HPD item we heard 16 today for a project located in Chair Salamanca's 17 District in the Bronx; a vote concerning Land Use 18 Item 238 for the H and H operating agreement 19 application, which was submitted by DCAS for the 20 transfer of various City-owned properties to the New 21 York City Health and Hospitals Corporation pursuant 2.2 to the terms of a 1970 operating agreement. Today, we 23 are voting to approve the transfer of the following City-owned properties into that 1970 agreement: in 24 25 the Bronx, North Central Bronx Hospital, 3424-28

In Brooklyn, Gotham-Cumberland Clinic, 39 9 Auburn Place, located in Council Member Hudson's District; Woodhill Hospital, 780 Broadway, located in 10 Council Member Chi Ossé's District; Gotham East New 11 York, 2094 Pitkin Avenue, in Council Member Banks' 12 13 District; and in Manhattan, Gotham-Governor 227 14 Madison Street, located in Council Member Marte's 15 District.
