Citizen's Complaint Review Board. We held public hearings on both of these items during October 9th meeting.

We will vote to approve M71-2024, a communication from the Queens Borough President submitting the name of Oudeshram "Raj" Rampershad to the Council for his advice and consent regarding his reappointment to the City Planning Commission pursuant to sections 31 and 192 of the City Charter. If reappointed, Mr. Rampershad will serve the remainder of a five-year term that began on July 1, 2023, and that expires on June 30, 2028.

We will also vote pursuant to Rule 10.60 of the Rules of the Council and Section 440 of the New York City Charter to approve Resolution 579 for the year 2024, an appointment by the Council of Dr. Mohammad Khalid, a resident of Staten Island, to the Civilian Complaint Review Board. If appointed by the Council, Dr. Khalid will serve for the remainder of a three-year term that expires on July 4, 2025.
